- **RECOVER Basic Life Support (BLS) and Advanced Life Support (ALS) guidelines (Including 2024 2.0 update)**
- **The Primary Survey**
- **Application of the Pit-Crew model from human medicine to veterinary medicine**
- **Team dynamics and human factors**
- **Low-probability, High-impact events**
- **Post-arrest management and debrief**
- **Catastrophic Haemorrhage**

This course is aimed at the whole practice including animal care assistants, student and qualified veterinary nurses, and veterinary surgeons.
